

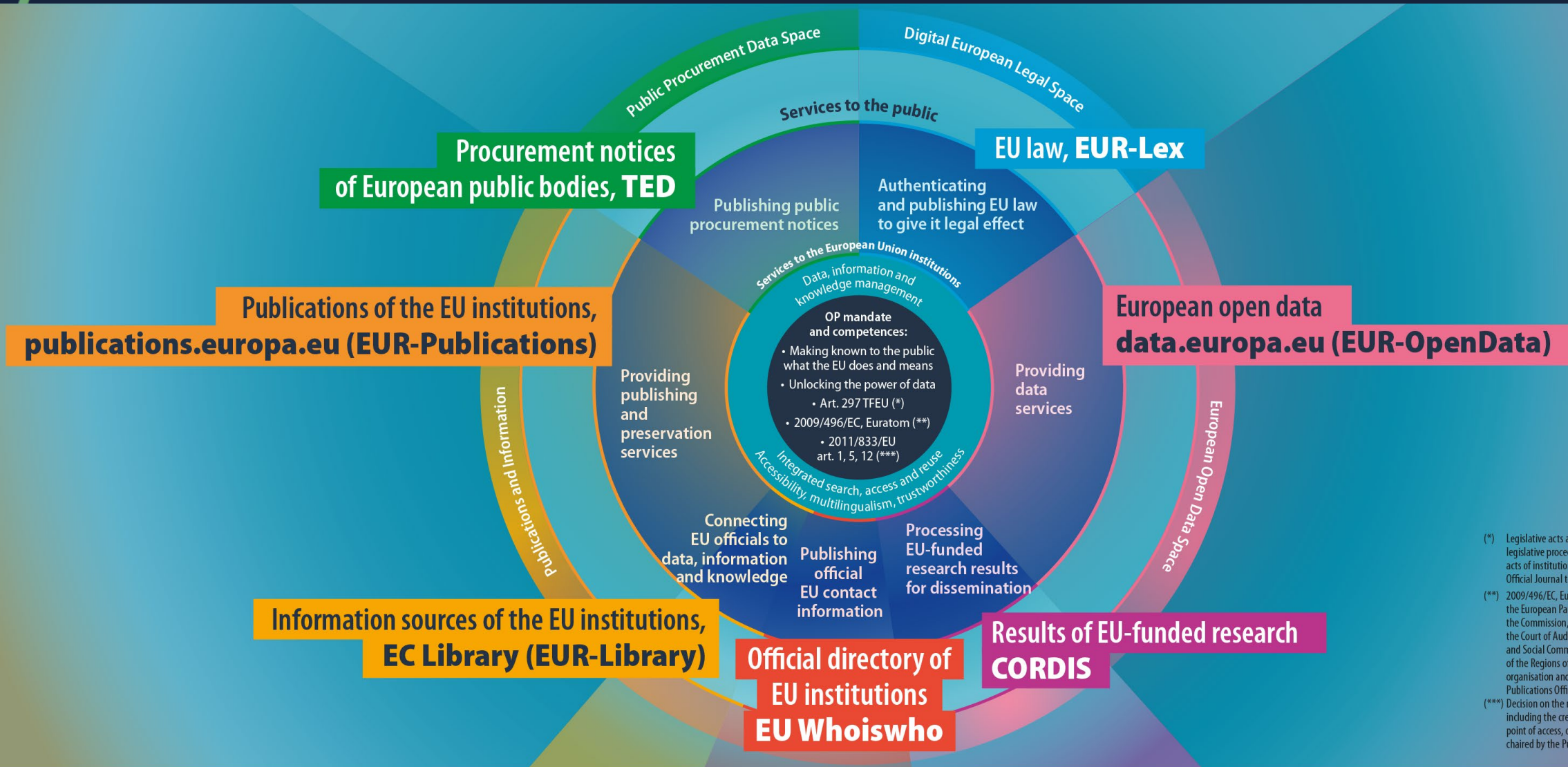

(*) Legislative acts adopted under the ordinary legislative procedure and non-legislative acts of institutions must be published in the Official Journal to enter into force.

(**) 2009/496/EC, Euratom: Decision of the European Parliament, the Council, the Commission, the Court of Justice, the Court of Auditors, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions of 26 June 2009 on the organisation and operation of the Publications Office of the European Union.

(***) Decision on the reuse of Commission documents, including the creation of a data portal as single point of access, overseen by a steering committee chaired by the Publications Office.
