

Reuse of ELI metadata from Legifrance

- **November 2014:** Initial versions of the main texts published in the OJ on Légifrance have an ELI URI (since 1/1/2002).
- **June 2015:** Publishing “Technical documentation” on eli.fr, with details about URI schema and implementation of metadata for OJ texts in XHTML pages.
- **July 2015:** Introduction of RDFa. Birth of semantic relations between French NIM transposing EU Directives. Example:

- **State of play 1/1/2016:**

- 158,000 texts with URI ELI and metadata.
