











## Reuse of ELI metadata from Legifrance

- November 2014: Initial versions of the main texts published in the OJ on Légifrance have an ELI URI (since 1/1/2002).
- June 2015: Publishing "Technical documentation" on elifr, with details about URI schema and implementation of metadata for OJ texts in XHTML pages.
- July 2015: Introduction of RDFa. Birth of semantic relations between French NIM transposing EU Directives.
