What notices must be published in TED?




- From EU member states, candidate countries, EEA countries, and Switzerland
 - Works, supplies, services
 - Utilities
- From the EU institutions, agencies and other bodies
 - Works, supplies, services
 - Calls for expression of interest
 - Annual list of contractors
- Notices for projects financed by:
 - European Investment Bank
 - European Investment Fund
 - European Central Bank
 - European Bank for Reconstruction and Development
 - External Aid and European Development Fund



Who publishes in TED?







Key facts on TED data

■ TED content in figures

- +/- 520 000 notices published/year
- Approximately € 460 billion worth calls for tenders/year
- More than 47 million notices consulted/year

Data formats available

- TED website: HTML, PDF, XML since 2011
- FTP: since 1993 (formats availability according to the year of publication)

Number of downloads

- 21 000 from website
- 1 168 000 from FTP
- Total of 1 189 000 downloads
- Almost 100 000 per month

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




EU public procurement data

- EU Open Data Portal (https://data.europa.eu/euodp/data/dataset/ted-1): a CSV sub-set of most important fields from contract notices and contract award notices since 2006 (DG GROW)
- Daily and monthly sub-sets of all published notices (TED)
- TED data is the most viewed data set of the EU Open Data Portal








How is TED data used





Single Market Scoreboard - DG GROW - TED data based




- One bidder
 - Shows lack of competition or too much bureaucracy
- No calls for bids
 - Too much direct negotiations
- 3. Publication rate
 - Value of procurement advertised on TED (% of GDP)
- 4. Cooperative Procurement
 - Multiple buyers bulk purchasing leads to better prices
- 5. Award criteria
 - Not only on lower price, but takes quality into account
- 6. Decision speed
 - Slow awards create costs and uncertainty
- 7. Missing award values
 - No value of contract published
- 8. Missing Calls for Bids
 - Award without easy link to CfT
- 9. Missing Registration Numbers
 - No easy identification of who is buying


2. overall (all 9 indicators combined)

■ A project to display the number of daily contract notices per geographical area (awaiting the new NUTS boundaries)








NUTS level 1 NUTS level 2 NUTS level 3



Main current data quality issues

Challenges

- Missing or incomplete fields
- Wrong values: typos, wrong currencies, code errors (CPV, NUTS)
- No way to consolidate by contracting authorities (no unique ID)
- No way to consolidate by economic operators (no unique ID)
- Contract notice without contract award notice and vice versa
- Some countries publish fewer notices than their size would suggest
- A lot of corrigenda notices : about 14 %

Conclusion

• Aware of data shortcomings, with careful interpretation, use this unique data richness!



Future projects



- Increase data quality (mandatory fields and controlled input)
- More information about tenders (e.g. structured tender values, awardee)
- More reuse formats (CSV and JSON)
- Keep offering raw TED data to reusers and add own data analytics
