
Everything started here

"the rules", professionalization and data storage




Civil Society: monitoring and control of procurement




Open Contracting Data Standard






Open contracting is an approach to improving public procurement through: open data, monitor data and get feedback from business and civil society

Open Contracting Data Standard





An open data schema describing how to release documents and data at each stage of a contracting process as machine readable, flexible, extensible, user friendly data

All information available to everyone






Public BI module (bi.prozorro.org) provides all information in a best-in-class format (Qlik software)

No accessible and reliable data on PP globally



Data driven decisions are impossible without information exchange and easily accessible, detailed and reliable statistics

Challenges of data interpretation and analysis

Incomplete statistical data within the GPA Parties



No single standard for procurement reports

No recent statistics on global procurement (latest is of 2002)

Scarce information does not allow businesses and even GPA Parties to evaluate all advantages and opportunities of the GPA

How to tackle these issues?



Portal for e-notices

 Create a unified e-portal to aggregate procurement procedures announcements within the GPA using the already tested Open Contracting Data Standard

Business Intelligence

 Implement Business intelligence module (BI) as data analytics tool for monitoring and analysis of procurement information for GPA Parties

Future vision



Unified e-platform with information on public procurement of the GPA parties will ...



- provide additional opportunities for business and increase fair competition
- enhance internal statistics and reporting systems
- deepen cooperation among the GPA parties
- ensure accessibility for analysis and public oversight
- give acceding GPA Members a better sense of the market access benefits that await them

Project development

- Pilot e-portal project within the GPA
- Involve countries willing to share data
- Based on Open Contracting Data Standard

Minimum viable product

• Launch MVP (Minimum Viable Product) of e-portal with e-notices of tenders under GPA rules (initial stage)

Business intelligence tools

- Develop business intelligence tools for data collection and analysis
- Agree on unified report structure and layout

2 years of the reform: from concept to system prozorro

March 2014 Volunteers' team setup

September, 2014 ePlatforms & final concept; first "seeding"

April, 2015 Volunteers move into gov't

June, 2015 First donor support

December, 2015 New Law on eProcurement. approval

> August 2016 Law comes into force for all buyers

April-May 2014 First search & first concept

February, 2015 **MVP** development & launch

May, 2015 MinDefence & small procurements' pilot

April, 2016 Law comes into force for big buyers
