

- High expectations, low immediate results






The EUR series of reports

 Reports published as a result of scientific and technical research programmes and studies funded by the European Commission.

Assigned a sequential 'EUR number', starting with 1, up to, currently, about 31 000.





Surprise, embarrassment, anger

- A classic case of phantom reference?



Finally, we found the report!











Filling the gaps



Physical/digital archives: 25.598/30.000 EUR numbers represented (30.143 documents)



EC Library: 8.512/30.000 EUR numbers represented (10468 documents)

 It is not possible to have everything and to keep everything




Making a distinction

• Publications of the European Union Institutions







Cure and prevention
