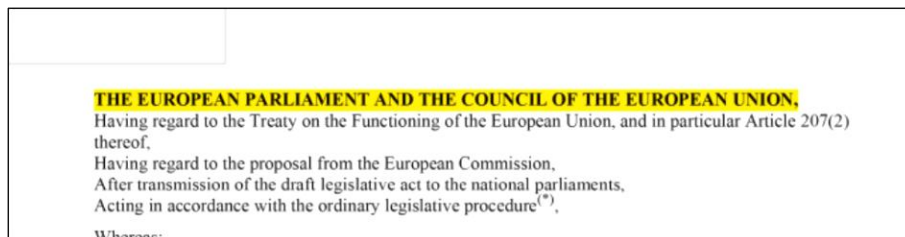

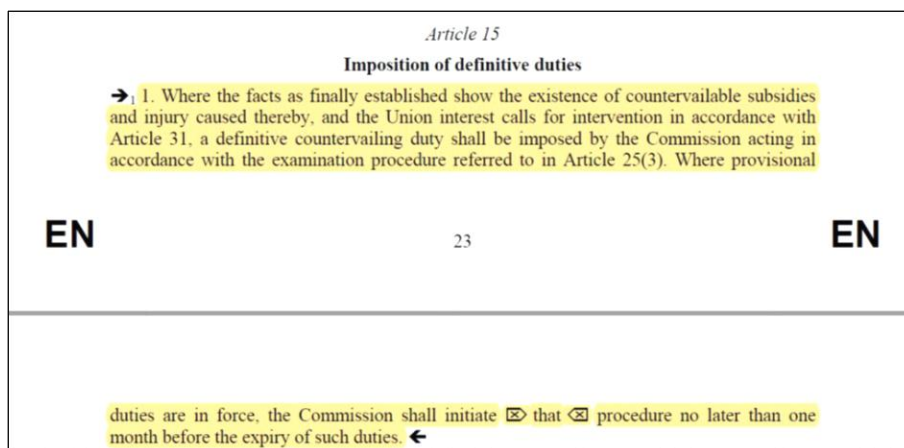

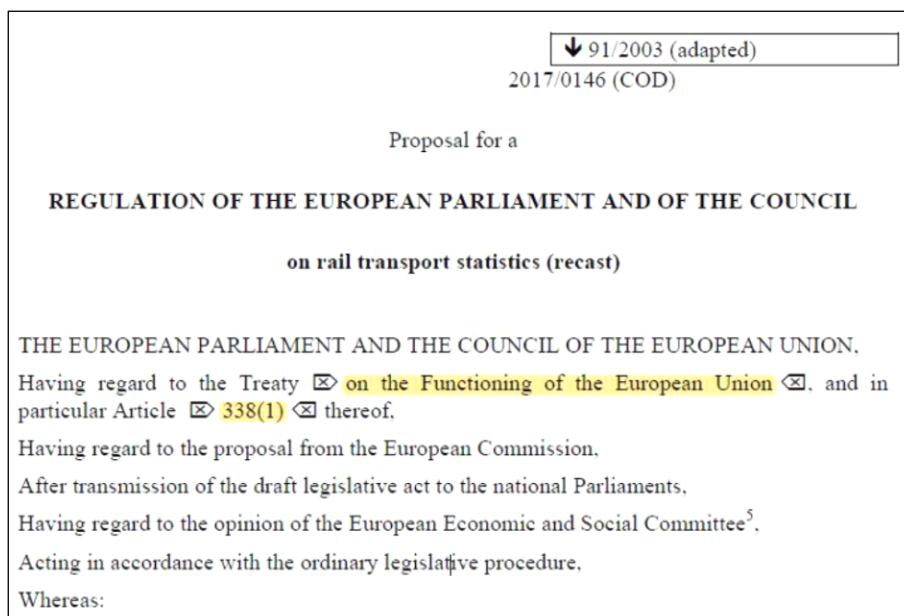

- **BR_2** (Concerns: [article](#), [point](#))
By way of exception, in the article on definitions and in amending provisions, if there is more than one definition or amendment, the numbering of points starts with Arabic numerals within brackets for the first level.
- **BR_3** (Concerns: [article](#), [numbered paragraph](#), [subparagraph](#))
When, among several paragraphs, one is numbered, the other paragraphs are also numbered. The numbered paragraphs can have subparagraphs that are always unnumbered.
- **BR_4** (Concerns: [indent](#), [introductory part](#), [point](#))
A list is a succession of at least two points or indents preceded by an introductory part.
- **BR_5** (Concerns: [indent](#), [point](#))
In legal acts, indents are used after the third level of points.
- **BR_6** (Concerns: [text of the amendment](#), [text to be amended](#), [corrigendum](#), [Commission corrigendum](#))
The text of the amendment or text to be amended is enclosed between quotation marks. Quotation marks do not form part of the text of the amendment or of the text to be amended.
- **BR_7** (Concerns: [chapter](#), [part](#), [section](#), [title](#))
Usage of the higher subdivisions varies according to drafting needs, only the hierarchy of subdivisions is fixed.
- **BR_8** (Concerns: [annex](#), [point](#), [subject](#), [subparagraph](#))
In annexes, subparagraphs are used to structure text belonging to the same point. However, the first subparagraph can be designated as the subject of the current point. Following the same approach, the content of a point followed by points at lower level can be designated as a subject.
- **BR_9** (Concerns: [closing part](#))
'Sandwich' constructions in enumerations using a closing part should be avoided.
- **BR_10** (Concerns: [international agreement](#), [recital](#))
In international agreements, recitals are not numbered but the first word or expression in each recital is capitalized.
- **BR_11** (Concerns: [international agreement](#), [numbered paragraph](#), [point](#))
In international agreements, certain paragraphs are used in a similar way as independent points in annexes.
- **BR_12** (Concerns: [citation](#), [EP legislative resolution](#))
In EP legislative resolutions, citations start with a dash.
- **BR_13** (Concerns: [article](#), [enacting terms](#), [EP legislative resolution](#), [numbered paragraph](#))
In EP legislative resolutions, enacting terms contain no article. Instead, numbered paragraphs indicate independent subdivisions, which can be, rarely, further sub-divided.
- **BR_14** (Concerns: [enacting terms](#), [preamble](#), [quotation](#))
Quotations shall not be used in the enacting terms nor in the preamble. The only exception would be in the recitals, where they are to be avoided as much as possible.
- **BR_15** (Concerns: [EP text adopted](#))
In a European Parliament Adopted Text, when an agreement is reached between the institutions, the consolidated text accompanying the legislative resolution of the Parliament might be abridged.
- **BR_16** (Concerns: [EP text adopted](#))
When an EP Adopted Text comprises an EP Consolidated Text, it has to be considered as a special annex to the Adopted Text that cannot be separated of it.

- **BR_17** (Concerns: [indent](#))
In documents other than legal acts, the sign used to start an indent can be a dash or a bullet.
- **BR_18** (Concerns: [numbered paragraph](#), [subparagraph](#), [unnumbered paragraph](#))
In documents other than legal acts or in international agreements, paragraphs and subparagraphs can be composed of an enumeration of points or indents, without an introductory part.
- **BR_19** (Concerns: [annex](#))
In legal acts, an annex to an annex is an appendix.
- **BR_20** (Concerns: [working comment](#))
A working comment is always wrapped between an opening and a closing square bracket or an opening and a closing curly bracket. The text of the document to which the working comment refers to may also appear between those opening and closing square brackets/curly brackets. The closing square bracket/curly bracket, however, is always placed just after the working comment.
- **BR_21** (Concerns: [legislative financial statement](#), [legislative financial and digital statement](#))
In a Legislative Financial Statement or Legislative Financial and Digital Statement, a checkbox may contain other checkboxes; and a checkbox may be preceded by an indent (i.e. a dash: "-").
- **BR_22** (Concerns: [legislative financial statement](#), [legislative financial and digital statement](#))
In a Legislative Financial Statement or Legislative Financial and Digital Statement, a group of checkboxes may be preceded by an introductory text.
- **BR_23** (Concerns: [EC staff working document](#), [Council internal document](#), [EC communication concerning Council position](#), [legislative financial statement](#), [legislative financial and digital statement](#))
In some EC documents (legislative statement, Staff Working Documents, communications) and some internal Council documents, some parts of the document may appear outlined in a text box.
- **BR_24** (Concerns: [table](#))
Forms are rendered in a table.
- **BR_25** (Concerns: [correcting instruction](#))
Correcting instructions are used in texts adopted by the European Parliament.
- **BR_26** (Concerns: [technical adaptation](#))
Technical adaptations are used in texts adopted by the European Parliament.
- **BR_27** (Concerns: [EC staff working document](#))
In documents other than legal acts, indents can be preceded by dashes, bullets or other graphical symbols.
- **BR_28** (Concerns: [correlation table](#))
In codification and recast, a table in an annex presents in the form of a list, the repealed act with an outdent from its subsequent amendments.
- **BR_29** (Concerns: [text of the amendment](#), [text to be amended](#))
In EP corrigenda, which may correct, inter alia, a consolidated text, embedding 'insertion' and 'deletion' concepts to present the agreed amendments, the individual corrections are therefore presented using concepts 'text of the amendment' and 'text to be amended'.
- **BR_30** (Concerns: [annex](#))
In annexes of legal acts, it can be necessary to keep the current structure to reflect specific numbering. In such case, some of the elements would be kept with the text (Left empty) appearing centered in italic.
- **BR_31** (Concerns: [note](#), [EP text adopted](#), [amendment](#))
In an EP text adopted inside an amendment (on a table) a note without textual content represents a note that is not amended.

- **BR_32** (Concerns: [annex](#), [note](#))

Footnotes are in general introduced by consecutive numbering in legislative texts and appear at the bottom of the page of the text to which they relate. In acts containing annexes, the numbering of footnotes restarts for each annex.

- **BR_33** (Concerns: [table](#), [note](#))

In tables, footnotes are in general located in the last row or just below the table. In addition, the same footnote can be placed on more than one element of the table.

- **BR_34** (Concerns: [note](#))

*In amending acts, footnotes belonging to a provision adding or replacing text in an existing act are introduced by a consecutive number of asterisks (e.g. *, **, ***...) and appear immediately after the block of amending text (JH, D.12.). The footnotes appear before the end quote and appear as the last part of the block of amending text.*

- **BR_35** (Concerns: [EP text adopted](#), [amendment](#), [numbering](#), [note](#))

In European Parliament's amendments :

- *unchanged footnotes keep their original reference and are not highlighted in both columns.*
 - *amendments to the content of footnotes are highlighted in both columns, with the original reference unmodified.*
 - *deleted footnotes are highlighted in the original text and are removed from the amended text.*
 - *for new footnotes:*
 - *if the initial text already contains a footnote, the new reference starts with the numbering of the last footnote followed by a sequential letter (e.g. a, b, c...). If the footnote comes before the first footnote (x) of the original text, it is numbered -(x)a.*
 - *if the initial text does not contain a footnote, the new reference starts at 1a and continues with consecutive letters.*
- **BR_36** (Concerns: [note](#))

Technical footnotes are instructions to the Publication Office to insert in the text, before publication, information which is purely technical in nature and which therefore does not affect the substance in any way, such as the sequential number of an act which is not yet published. Technical footnotes are introduced by increasing numbers of "plus" signs (+).

- **BR_37** (Concerns: [text of the amendment](#))

In amending acts, the text of the amendment represents the text to be inserted in accordance with an amending instruction referring to insertion, addition or replacement.

- **BR_38** (Concerns: [working comment](#))

The working comment concept may optionally be used to mark symbols representing missing information to be inserted later, in particular in EP documents.
