This is when public management is carried out in the open, communicated clearly, without technicalities.









#### Number of announcements - Portal BASE.GOV



#### **Planning**

- Identifying needs
- Selection of the type of procedure
- Definition of the selection criteria
- Definition of the award criteria

#### Contract

 Publication of the contract notice according to the European thresholds

#### Awarding of contract

- Receipt and analysis of tenders
- Choice of tender based on award criteria
- Signing of the contract

#### Contract award notice

 Publication of the contract award notice according to the European thresholds

#### Performance of the contract

- Receipt of the order/works
- Invoicing
- Payment







