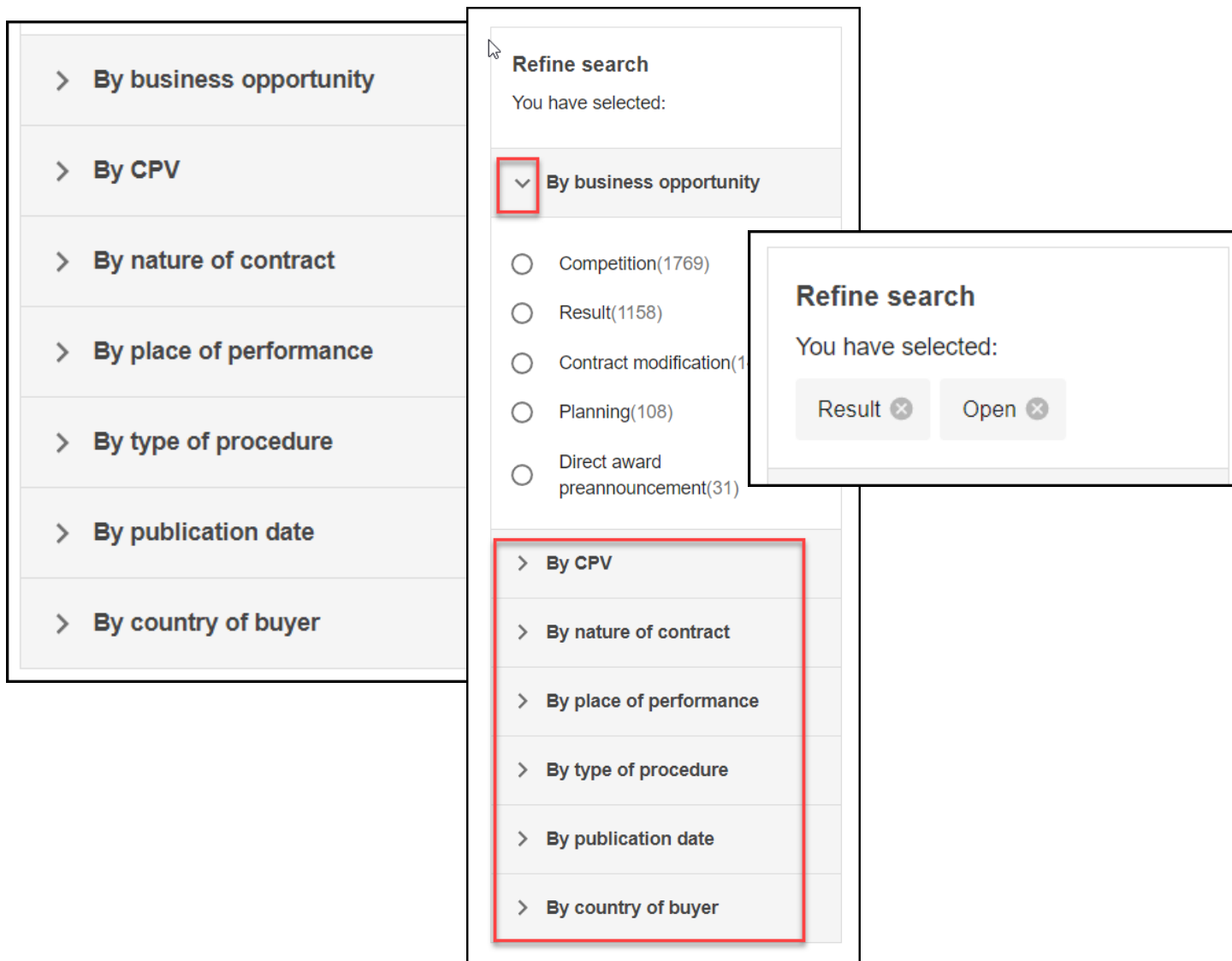

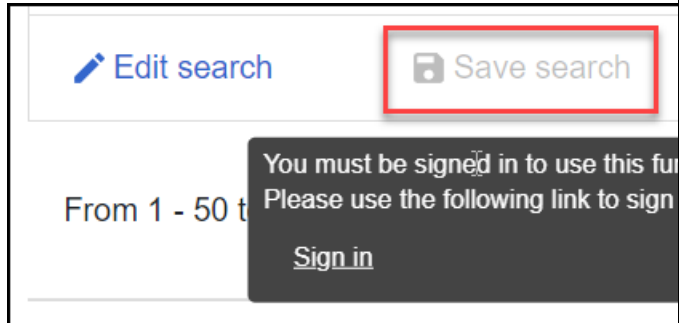
How to take advantage of the powerful filtering options

- Adapt dynamically

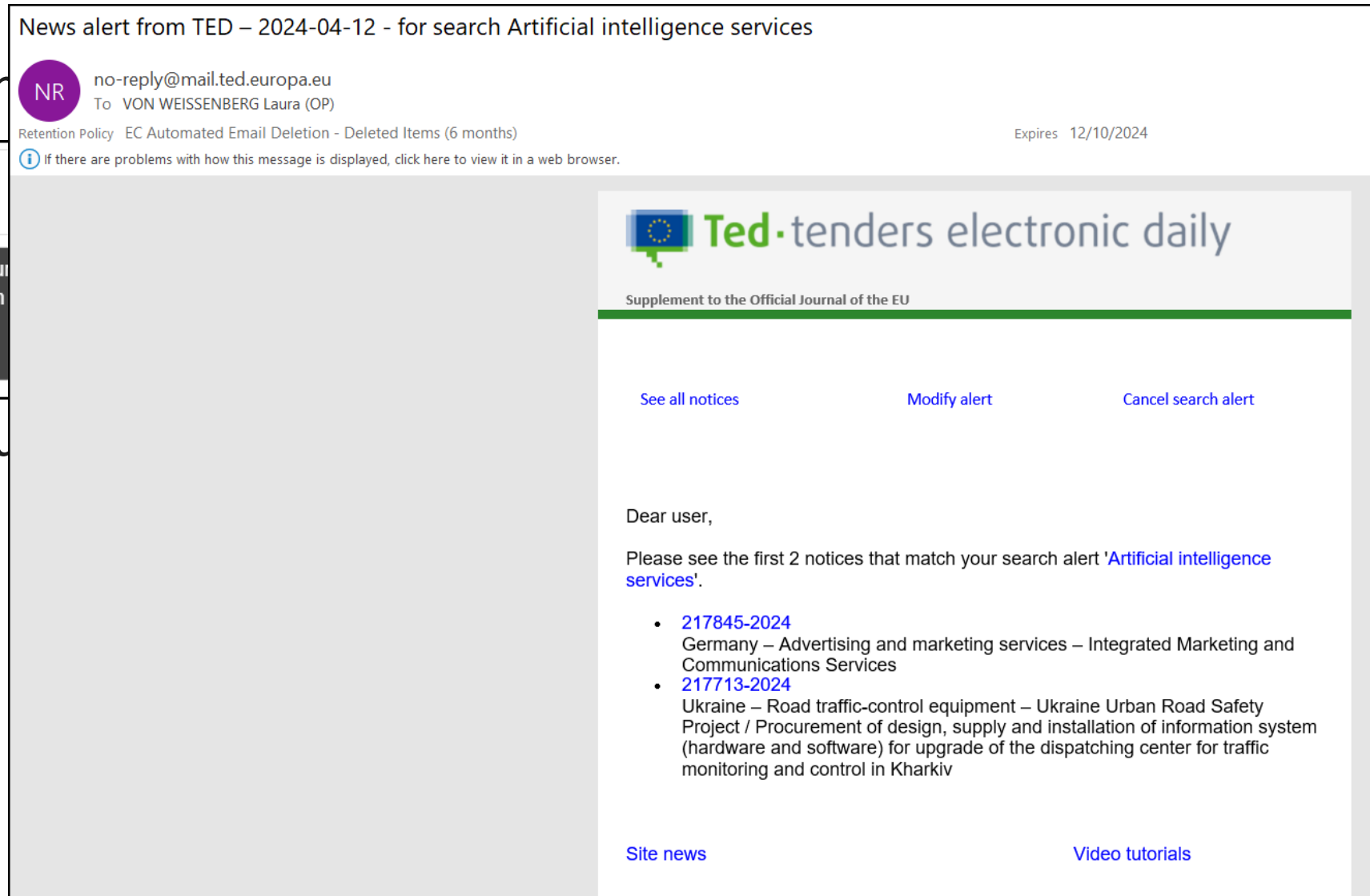

How to upgrade your game with the expert search

- Allows you to perform complex queries
- You can use either code or text
- You can verify validity of the syntax
- You can browse or filter in the search tree
