




## Poor exploitation of public procurement data




### **The PPDS Solution**

A data space that **consolidates the data from every public procurement data source** by providing interoperability of the data through a **common semantics using the eProcurement Ontology.** The PPDS provides **data analytical capabilities** to facilitate evidence-based decision making for buyers, suppliers and policy makers.


