

# National Database of Public Contracts



- 238,000 Companies
- 380,000 active users

- ✓ Over 30,000 economic operators Pre-Qualified for public works
- ✓ Over 650,000 certifications on the execution of public works


**Catalogo dei dati aperti** National Database of Public Contracts (BDNCP) (National Anti-Corruption Authority ANAC);
