Software Development Kit – the eForms technical specs

- **eForms implementing regulation** in 2019: new standard for EU procurement notices
- **SDK** represents the regulation annex as technical components for developers to use
 - UBL-based XML schema – but also validation rules, codelists, translations, screen/PDF templates
- eForms available since **November 2022**
- Member States/eSenders mainly went live between September 2023 and January 2024
- 100% eForms notices on TED since **1 July 2024**
- Notices provided by 51 public and commercial **eSenders** (85%) and by OP's **eNotices2** application (15%)
- Regulatory changes and sectoral legislation via **amendments** to eForms regulation (two so far)
- **Multiple SDK versions** in parallel, incremental improvements and corrections
- Significant effort to **upgrade** SDK versions, can be reduced by being metadata-driven
- Rate of **change** is slowing, better **governance** and planning

eSender survey: challenges, improvements needed, what to change

- **Time**: longer SDK **lifespans**, fewer versions, clearer roadmap, stronger **governance** framework, earlier consultation
- **SDK**: more **stability**, limit modifications, backwards compatibility, better documentation, better quality, improve **rule** messages, translations and example XMLs, non-Java technologies, fuller test environment, explain source of rules and fields, alternatives to view-templates
- **Upgrades**: finding what really **changed**, tailoring, adapt existing eProc systems, a single rule can have ramifications, regression **testing**, plan external contractors, zero commercial benefit
- **Regulatory**: **simplify** procedures, fields, rules, xPaths, Results, fewer mandatory fields, replace CPV, stop buyers bypassing national platforms

SDK 1.14 scope – planned for September 2025

Intermediate/maintenance release, including clarifications and improvements for **rules**:

- Organisations and roles, e.g. lead buyer, CPB, joint procurement
- Direct award
- Multistage and participant reductions
- Tendering statistics
- Enforce positive monetary amounts and limit to 2 decimals
- Consistent NUTS vs country
- Mandatory eSender role (only schema change currently planned)
- New financial regulation for EU institutions (legal basis)
- etc...





Where does SDK2 fit in?

- SDK 2.0 aims to provide business equivalence with SDK 1.14
 - Same XML schema
 - Same business rules but some will be expressed differently in EFX2
 - possibly some dynamic rules to prove the concept, e.g. check linked notice has been published
 - Improved EFX2 for view-templates for PDF and HTML generation
- Aim: no impact if you don't use EFX (eForms expression language)
- 3rd amendment to eForms regulation will be implemented *only* in SDK 2.1 in 2026

3rd eForms amendment – in SDK 2.1 in 2026



- Move fields from lot to procedure
- Question the need for group of lots (GLO) and touchpoints (TPO)
- Rework “unpublished” (non-public) fields
- Revisit versioning of notices
- Clarify and improve framework agreements (FA) and dynamic purchasing systems (DPS)
- Include forms T01 and T02 (passenger transport regulation 1370/2007)
- Better registration numbers for organisations
- Allow NUTS2
- etc...

All depends on DG GROW guides and consultation with Member States via eForms governance

Revision of EU procurement directives

- Ongoing evaluation by European Commission
- Hundreds of replies to open public consultation and call for evidence
- Input from public authorities, business, wide range of stakeholders
- Many targeted consultations, meetings, studies
- First draft proposal by Q4 2026
