












Madame Constance gives Anna some paper and colouring pencils. Anna loves colouring. Before long, she and Madame Constance are drawing a picture together.

Madame Constance teaches Anna the names of some colours: rouge, vert, bleu, jaune. Anna repeats every word. Maybe French is not so difficult after all.


'I just need to listen very hard, like Daddy says. Soon I'll be better than him,' Anna thinks, smiling to herself.

Madame Constance changes her voice.






When Daddy comes to collect Anna after school, she is singing the song she learned in class. Daddy gives her a big hug.


'Wow! You're already singing in French, Anna! I'm so proud of you,' he says.
