

COMMISSION DECISION

of 3 February 1976

fixing, pursuant to the invitation to tender opened by Regulation (EEC) No 3405/75, the maximum amount for the costs of delivery of skimmed-milk powder

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 740/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7(5) thereof,

Whereas, pursuant to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3405/75 of 30 December 1975⁽³⁾, the Belgian intervention agency has invited tenders for delivery to the Republic of Rwanda of one lot of 350 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder;

Whereas Article 5 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2557/74 of 4 October 1974 concerning the invitation to tender for the costs of delivery, as food aid, of skimmed-milk powder to certain third countries⁽⁴⁾, provides that in the light of the tenders received the maximum amount is to be fixed or the tendering procedure is to be cancelled;

Whereas, on the basis of the tenders received the maximum amount should be that specified below;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The maximum amount to be set for the purpose of awarding a contract pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 3405/75 shall be 2.186 units of account.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Kingdom of Belgium.
