

REGULATION (EEC) No 609/74 OF THE COMMISSION  
of 15 March 1974

amending Regulation (EEC) No 2637/70 on the securities relative to export licences  
in the milk and milk products sector

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the Euro-  
pean Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
804/68 <sup>(1)</sup> of 27 June 1968 on the common organi-  
zation of the market for milk and milk products, as  
last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 419/74 <sup>(2)</sup>,  
and in particular Articles 13 (3) and 17 (4) thereof ;

Whereas the amount of the security for export  
licences in the milk and milk products sector have  
been fixed in Article 37 of Commission Regulation  
(EEC) No 2637/70 <sup>(3)</sup> of 23 December 1970 on  
special detailed rules for the application of the  
system of import and export licences and advance  
fixing certificates for agricultural products, as last  
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 389/74 <sup>(4)</sup> ;

Whereas, under present market conditions, some of  
these amounts must be increased, so as to enable the  
obligation to export during the period of validity  
of the export certificate to be met ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation  
are in accordance with the Opinion of the Manage-  
ment Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

*Article 1*

The text of Article 37 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No  
2637/70 is replaced by the following :

2. The amount of security for export licences  
for the products listed in Article 1 of Regulation  
(EEC) No 804/68, per 100 kg net, be :

- 0.25 units of account for products falling  
within tariff heading No 04.01 A of the  
Common Customs Tariff ;
- 3.00 units of account for products falling  
within subheading No 04.02 A II b) or 04.02  
B I b) 2, or, within heading No 04.03, of the  
Common Customs Tariff ;
- 2.00 units of account for other products.'

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 16 March  
1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
