

**Communication from the Commission pursuant to Article 4 of Council  
Regulation (EEC) No 2761/72 of 19 December 1972**

Pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2761/72 <sup>(1)</sup> of 19 December 1972 on the opening, allocation and administration of Community tariff quotas for certain products originating in developing countries, notice is hereby given that charges at Community level, against the Community tariff quota, in respect of products originating in the countries and territories specified below have reached the relevant maximum amount laid down in column 4 of Annex A of that Regulation.

The normal Common Customs Tariff duties are, consequently, reintroduced for the abovementioned products originating in Malaysia specified in relation to each one of them, from 27 December 1973.

**Notice of the Commission concerning the application  
of the monetary compensatory amounts**

The attention of interested parties is drawn to the fact that the Republic of Italy has made known its intention of renouncing the application of Article 2 (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 as from 15 January 1974.

Therefore, for the products for which the customs formalities for exports will be completed after 14 January 1974 in an exporting Member State and which will be imported by Italy, the monetary compensatory amounts resulting from the imports into Italy will be claimed by Italy.
