

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 349/95**of 21 February 1995****establishing the quantity of certain cheeses available for the second quarter of 1995 under the arrangements provided for by the Interim Agreements concluded by the Community with Bulgaria and Romania**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1588/94 of 30 June 1994 laying down detailed rules for the application to milk and milk products of the arrangements provided for in the Interim Agreements between the Community, of the one part, and Bulgaria and Romania, of the other part ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 3337/94 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 4 ⁽⁴⁾ thereof,Whereas, pursuant to Commission Regulation (EC) No 89/95 ⁽³⁾ determining the extent to which applications lodged in January 1995 for import certificates for these products may be accepted, the applications for import licences lodged cover a smaller quantity of products than

those available; whereas, the quantity of each product available for the period 1 April to 30 June 1995 should be established,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The quantity available for the period 1 April to 30 June 1995 pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1588/94 is set out in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 22 February 1995.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
