

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1882/1999**  
**of 31 August 1999**  
**on tenders submitted under the invitation to tender for beef put up for sale in Regulation (EC) No 1611/1999**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organisation of the market in beef and veal <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1633/98 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 7(3) thereof,

- (1) Whereas quantities of beef fixed by Commission Regulation (EC) No 1611/1999 <sup>(3)</sup> have been offered for sale by periodic invitation to tender;
- (2) Whereas, pursuant to Article 9 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2173/79 <sup>(4)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 2417/95 <sup>(5)</sup>, minimum sales prices for the meat offered for tender are to be fixed in the light of the tenders received; whereas, for the invitation to tender referred to in Article 2(1)(c) of Regulation (EC)

No 1611/1999, the tenders received do not allow minimum prices to be fixed;

- (3) Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

No action shall be taken on the basis of the tenders submitted under the invitation to tender referred to in Article 2(1)(c) of Regulation (EC) No 1611/1999.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 September 1999.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
